Top Goal Scorer of Wendron:

Many players of our football section have achieved many things within our club, from Antony Williams playing a total of 700 games to Matthew Hassle being our top record of goals in men's football with 215 goals in 178 games. Justin Searle has managed to remain on 215 goals this month playing 494 games of mens football for Wendron, by scoring another goal, Justin will beat the record for top goal scorer. Just within the first team games, Justin has played 173 games with 83 goals scored which makes him fifth in our first team top goal scorers. What an achievement, Justin Searle has been such a dedicated player at our club for many years, starting with us from youth football and carrying on with us into the men's section currently playing for our third team on Saturdays and veterans on Sundays. Hope Justin is proud of himself and we are happy to have him as part of our club.



The top 5 goalscorers of Wendron starts with Matthew Hassle first and Justin Searle still remaining second. Third is Michael O'Neill who is our first team manager standing at 303 games with 186 goals. Fourth is Zac Alexander who is a current Wendron player playing for our thirds and veterans standing at 220 games with 147 goals. Fifth stands Guil Mcivor who is also one of our current players playing for our fourth team and veterans with 248 games and 144 goals.



Matthew Hassle is still currently our first team's top goal scorer by 172 games with 205 goals. Michael O'Neill comes second from playing 243 goals with 151 goals, Antony Harris being third with 325 games with 96 goals, Luke Wort being fourth with 84 games and 102 goals and Justin Searle still remains fifth with 173 games and 83 goals scored.

Cricket Statistics:

Ahead of the 2024 season, our cricketers carry on the Indoor Cricket League with their next game being held Sunday 25th February against Ladock, Super Goats currently staying second in the league and also this month cricket nets will be back on Friday 23rd February. Player profiles have been announced for a few of our players in January. Keenan Carpenter who is our youngest first team player and continues to be the club's Evening Leagues captain. He has played 79 games for our cricket section, standing at 479 runs with 77 wickets. Craig Owens who has played many years, and a current first team player, he has played 195 cricket matches, standing at 2035 runs with 127 wickets.
